The page is mainly about ducks and a condition called "wet feather" but the first few paragraphs apply to all birds.

There are several reasons birds preen.

"It [preening] includes the removal of parasites, the removal of scales which cover newly sprouting feathers, and also the spreading of oil over clean feathers. It also includes the combing of the barbs on the feather so that the barbules and even smaller hooks called barbicelli interlock and form a protective layer to repel water."







A friend wanted to know where owls came from so I looked it up. Interesting, barn owls are in a different family from most other owls.

Archaeopteryx was the first bird, some 150 million years ago. Along the way, owls evolved as their own species, being found to live some 60 million years ago, if not sooner. Owls were more successful than other birds, filling every role of birds as we know them today, until other birds became more successful and the owls started dying out, leaving just two main families, the Strigidae (all owls except Barn owls and Grass owls) and the then more common Tytonidae (Barn owls and Grass owls).

Gradually, the typical owls (Strigidae) over took the Tytonidae, the Strigidae became the more common family, some 200 different species, the Tytonidae have around 17 different species.



She thinks they don't have sufficient perches and they don't have a way for owlets to get back up to the box if they fall. She believes there should be laws enacted to specify construction details. I'm not sure about this but I think she's trying to talk Carlos into putting in some type of slanted ramp so the owlets could climb back up to the box if necessary.
