



Cleaning Owl Box (October - November)

Tools needed: rubber gloves, face mask, trowel or other scrapping tool or crow bar, trash bag or box, tool to open the box.

Wear the mask and gloves.

Always have a helper to hold the ladder steady, and to stand by while you are at the box. Peek into the box. If you see an owl, retreat and remove the ladder.

Once the box is open, use your scraper or crow bar to loosen up the tightly compacted "carpet" inside. Scrape the carpet and all other debris into the trash bag, or box, or onto the ground (it's biodegradable but possibly toxic!). If box is very wet inside, try to determine why – wetness can create bacteria and is unhealthy for the owls.

Do not leave any material inside box.

Close the box.
