They prey much eat roots, LOVE people's bulb flowers and will dig up the bulbs even in off season. They do not like Iris plants so those are often planted in people's landscape. People here will ask a nursery what to plant that Javelinas do not like. We had some potted cactus plants on side of house and they literally mowed (ate) one down to the dirt. They will eat the type of cactus that have the long tyenes (not sure if that is the spelling) but they look like toothpicks on the cactus. Amazing creatures!
