2. Create a folder on your hard drive to save the images in
3. Open the unzipped folder and double left click on "UOSJ.exe"
4. Browse to the folder where you want to save the images.
5. Press "ESC" to capture the image you want.

This take a picture of your entire desk top window and saves it as a .BMP file in the assigned folder.

If you want to get rid of the excess and keep only the picture of the owls, you will need a graphic program such as Windows Paint or some other one like Paint Shop Pro, Photoshop or GIMP etc.

The nice thing about this program is that it allows you to take images rather quickly.
