She was illegally given to someone who thought if she was raised on their property she would hunt the animals in the area. A friend was concerned about her behavior and so they called Carolina Raptor Center for advice, but by the time she was brought to our facility she was already imprinted on humans. When owls hatch, they look to their parents to learn that they are an owl. Unfortunately, because Willow was raised by people, she never had the opportunity to learn she was an owl, and therefore would not be able to survive on her own in the wild. She came to CRC in her hatching year and has been with us since July of 2007.
